Message from Mrs Hughes

Dear Families

Welcome back to the summer term and I hope you all enjoyed a restful holiday. I also hope that all our families who celebrated Eid last week, enjoyed this special family time together.

Our sincere thanks to the PTA for organising another successful event - Russ's Magic Show. I know how much the children were looking forward to it, with great excitement in the younger classrooms.

It was lovely to see so many proud parents and carers coming out of parents' evening appointments this week. Working in partnership ensures that your children make the most progress and we are grateful for all your support. 
