

Listening to your child read

What can you do to help at home?

1. Use pure sounds, not letter names
2. Use Fred Talk to read and spell words
3. Listen to your child read their reading book every day
(First read- read it to your child and put the voices on. Then echo read each page before building up to your child reading the full book, independently.)
4. Read stories to your child every day (their school library book is a good place to start.)
5. Use the green flick book regularly
6. Record all reading on the Go-Read app
