How can I find out more about the EYFS?

How can I contribute to my child's learning?

- Work to support the phonics programme, which will be regularly sent home for you to complete with you child.
- Individual reading scheme books and books selected by your child will be sent home for you to share. Please read these books to your child, do not expect them to read completely independently straight away. Also, bedtime stories will continue to be extremely valuable.
- Use the handwriting resources to support correct letter formation.
- Talk to them about what they have done in their day.

How will I know about my child's progress?

- **Parents' evenings-** You may have the opportunity to look at your child's book, share any concerns and discuss their progress.
- **EYFS written reports-** You will receive three termly reports detailing your child's progress in their learning and their next steps on their learning journey.
