Dear Families,

Welcome back and I do hope you all enjoyed a restful holiday. It has been a pleasure to greet all of the children and see them looking so smart in their new uniform. They have all settled into the classroom routines and we have congratulated all our new Reception pupils in this morning's Celebration Assembly, as they have coped so well with a full first week and extremely hot temperatures!

I am delighted that the 25" and 27" blazers have arrived, and many children have already tried these on and taken them home. I know that there are still some items of uniform outstanding and we will keep in constant communication with Monkhouse and let you know as soon as these arrive. Please can I clarify for all those children who do have full uniform that **blazers need to be worn every day, including PE day**. All our pupils have tried extremely hard to arrive at school with ties on and shirts tucked in. We will keep on practising this with them, as they get used to wearing these items. Socks should be grey or white for girls and grey or black for boys. PE tracksuit bottoms need to be black with no large logos. I realise that some parents had purchased cardigans, but these are not an item of Tudor Grange uniform and therefore all children should now be wearing their blazer and jumper if they are feeling cold. Our focus in assembly on Monday was to think about dressing smartly and behaving smartly. Always showing respect and kindness to each other both in and out of school. I am delighted to share that the children have worn their uniform with pride, the atmosphere has been calm and caring and all have worked extremely hard this week. We are very proud of them.

Although we are no longer in class bubbles and have returned to the lunch hall to eat (sitting in separate year groups), we are still maintaining our increased cleaning schedule, regular hand washing and ventilation in all areas. We also request that all parents who attend the class Welcome To Meetings, wear a mask if possible and gel hands on entry to the classroom. We are maintaining our one-way system, in all areas of the school grounds for safety reasons. We understand that this may be frustrating for adults who want to enter via the KS2 playground gate, but this exit does become very congested. When adults exit both the infant middle gate and from the KS2 playground at the end of the day, we ask that you walk out via the car park, which is closed to cars at this time. Please do not walk back down the paths. As Covid 19 is still spreading in our community, maintaining distance is still very important and arriving for drop off and collection at the correct time will avoid large crowds of children and adults on the front entrance path. On Monday at 8.40am, I will call in the year groups allocated to that time first. Please do not arrive early. Thank you for your understanding and co-operation.

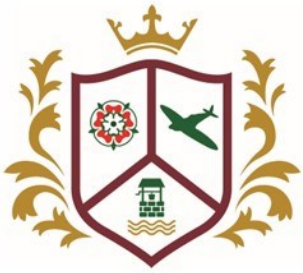
