Dear Families,

Our Celebration Assembly this morning gave me the opportunity to say, "Congratulations," to both pupils and staff. A look in the children's books this week showed care and hard work to ensure that handwriting and presentation was improved but most importantly a demonstration of focus and determination to improve! Well done to all the children and thank you to the staff, who have really supported the children to start the year so confidently.

Thank you to all the new Reception parents who were able to attend the Welcome To evening this week. It was a pleasure to meet you all and have the opportunity to share a little more information. I do hope that all the parents who have attended the meetings in other year groups have found them informative and if you were unable to attend, please email the year group to ask any questions.

Wrap around care has been very popular and we now have children from all year groups attending both Early Birds and Tudor Teatime. More information is available on our website if you need to book into this service.

I often explain to the children that one of my main jobs as Headteacher, is to ensure that they are safe. We regularly host assemblies focusing on safe behaviour and e-safety so that these messages are understood. In the wider community, we are building closer relationships with our local PCSO, to ensure that we focus on local issues and share messages.

Over the past few years, we have also been involved in a project called Operation Encompass. This was established to ensure good communication between police and schools, if there are incidents of domestic violence that involve our children in any way. We receive a notification if police have attended so that we can support the children and understand why they may be feeling unsettled. We will not discuss any information with them or approach you, but if a child or parent wants support, we are always here to offer it.

This newsletter is an excellent way to communicate a wide range of information with you, but we are often repeating dates and messages on a weekly basis. Therefore, we are proposing to send out this newsletter fortnightly, to ensure we maintain good communication, but it isn't too repetitive.

When do I need to self-isolate?

To keep life moving and stop Covid-19 from spreading further, it's still important to self-isolate when you're asked to.

There are new rules from 16 August:

Should I self-isolate if...

I've tested positive for Covid-19?

- I'm double-jabbed or I'm under 18 - and I've been in contact with someone who's tested positive?
- I've had either one or no jabs and I'm 18 or over - and I've been in contact with someone who's tested positive?
- I have symptoms of Covid-19 (high temperature, new continuous cough, loss or change to sense of smell or taste)?

A YES: You should self-isolate and take a PCR test, even if you've been vaccinated
