# PTA Newsletter

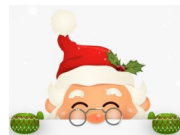

# When do I need to self-isolate?

To keep life moving and stop Covid-19 from spreading further, it's still important to self-isolate when you're asked to.

There are new rules from 16 August:

## Should I self-isolate if...

- |   |  |

| <b>Q</b> I've tested positive for Covid-19?   | <b>A</b> <b>YES:</b> You need to self-isolate, even if you've been vaccinated  |
| <b>Q</b> I'm double-jabbed or I'm under 18 - and I've been in contact with someone who's tested positive?                 | <b>A</b> <b>NO:</b> You do not need to self-isolate<br><b>BUT:</b> We advise you to take a PCR test, and you need to self-isolate if it's positive |
| <b>Q</b> I've had either one or no jabs and I'm 18 or over - and I've been in contact with someone who's tested positive? | <b>A</b> <b>YES:</b> You need to self-isolate  |
| <b>Q</b> I have symptoms of Covid-19 (high temperature, new continuous cough, loss or change to sense of smell or taste)? | <b>A</b> <b>YES:</b> You should self-isolate and take a PCR test, even if you've been vaccinated   |
