

## The Learning Partnership at Perdiswell

- ♦ Baseline Staff will assess and reflect on the skills and attributes of the children when they arrive in September.
- Class Blog A weekly snapshot of the children's learning that is shared on the school website.
- Parent's Evenings A supportive dialogue where staff will highlight progress and next steps.
- Reports-You will receive a termly report detailing your child's progress and identify next steps in their learning.
- Parents Phonics Workshop A supportive and informative workshop lead by our Reading Lead. This will inform you of how you can further support your child's reading at home.

- Support your child to manage their toileting needs independently

# **School Ready**

Singing lots of nursery rhymes, retelling familiar tales and joining in with a tune

Cutting, scooping and picking up my food with a knife, fork and spoon

Hopping, throwing, catching, climbing, balancing, running and baking

Opening lids, squeezing and brushing will make my body and hands ready for mark making

Organising my toys, putting them away and independently finding things I need

Listening for sounds in words and blending them together will help mw to later read Recognising my name will help me find my peg and drawer and put my belongings away

Eagerness to explore, join in with games, take turns and share will help me in my play

Asking for help from an adult if I hurt myself or need the loo

Dressing myself by putting on my coat and shoes is something to practise too

You will be ready, of that I am sure! Ready to start your exciting School adventure!
