PHONICS

- At Perdiswell, we follow Ruth Miskin Phonics. Home reading books are banded into colours. These books are designed to reinforce the phonics programme that the children are following. Children are assessed once per half term and moved phonics group accordingly.
- The children will follow a daily program of phonics/reading. This will take place for around 30 minutes at the start of each day.
- PReading is a key part of the children's learning and we ask that you try to read with your child at home as much as you can.

PHONICS SCREENING 2022

Every child in Year I is required to complete the phonics screening check.

This year's phonics screening will take place throughout the month of June.

SEND at Tudor Grange Perdiswell

- SENDCo Mrs Lucy Brooks. Working days Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday.
- The first line of support for all children with SEND is Quality First Teaching in the whole class. Lesson content is scaffolded to ensure all children have the support in place to be able to make progress. A range of resources are made available to ensure all children have strategies they can use to support their learning.
- If children need additional support in lessons, this will be allocated and delivered by a support assistant.
- At times, children may be identified for intervention to help them close gaps in their learning or support a speech and language or social and emotional need. Interventions are usually delivered in the afternoon by a support assistant. This year, children will attend interventions for a 6 week period, with approximately 2 sessions per week. This ensures interventions do not continue for long periods of time, reducing the amount of time they are with their peers in class. You will always be notified if your child has been highlighted for interventions.

If your child is on the register for SEND, they will have a Pupil Passport. This document is written by class teachers and parents. It is reviewed termly and new targets included if previous targets have been achieved. You will be invited to a termly meeting with your child's class teacher to discuss their passport and you will have a copy to keep at home.

PE

- PE takes place on a Thursday.
- Please ensure that your child is wearing their PE kit on their set PE day. (This includes trainers). They must also wear their blazer over the top.
- If possible, please keep earrings out for the PE day.
- Dur first two units for PE will be fundamentals and fitness.





E-SAFETY

E-safety is a high priority at Perdiswell. Children have weekly E-Safety lessons in school but we need your help at home.

Talk to your children about what they are looking at online and who they are talking to.

We encourage you to check your child's devices weekly and that the content, and conversations they are having are appropriate for their age group.

WhatsApp and Snapchat groups can become an issue even when these conversations are taking place outside of school. Children talk to their friends at home, sometimes get carried away by what they are saying and become unkind and hurtful towards others. This can have a significant impact on all children involved.

TikTok is another popular app, there can be inappropriate videos on the app, please be vigilant.

At Perdiswell, we take Online safety extremely seriously and all staff have access to The National Online Safety website for training, lessons and advice.

As part of our membership, all parents and carers have access to the website. A letter will be sent out in the next few weeks so you can access it for any support.


